PROSPECTUS for XXVII (27th) BALKAN YOUTH TABLE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS

ELIGIBILITY:

The 27th Youth Table Tennis Championships is open to all member of Balkan Table Tennis Union. All players must be eligible to represent their Associations in accordance with the rules of I.T.T.F and E.T.T.U, and shall be born on or after 1st January 2004 for a Cadet player and on or after 1st January 2001 for a Junior player.

Individual passports of the participants must be presented to the Technical Delegate and Referee.

RULES:

The championships will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis, the Regulations for International Competitions and the Regulation of Balkan Union.

EVENTS:

The championships shall include Junior Boys Team, Junior Girls Team, Cadet Boys Team, Cadet Girls Team, Junior Boys Single, Junior Girls Single, Cadet Boys Single, Cadet Girls Single, Junior Boys double, Junior Girls double, Cadet Boys double, Cadet Girls double, Junior Mixed double and Cadet Mixed double.

Cadet players are not allowed to participate in Junior singles and doubles events.

LEVIES:

The levies shall be 20 € for each team, 5€ for an individual entry in single and 10 € for a double pair. The above levies shall be paid to the General Secretary or Technical Delegate of B.T.T.U.

CANCELLATION FEES:

An Association/Federation cancelling a person of their announced delegation between the 7 and 15 days before the start of Championships, have to pay 50% of the hospitality costs for every person and for the whole period this person was initially nominated.

An Association/Federation cancelling a person of their announced delegation during the last 7 days before the start of Championships or arriving with less persons than announced, have to pay 100% of the hospitality costs for every person and for the whole period this person was initially nominated.

ENTRIES:

An Association may enter only 1 team in each team event.

For the team events each Association shall be entitled to enter up to 5 players in junior and up to 4 players in cadet category for the male and female team.

For the individual events the organizing Association shall be entitled to enter up to 24 players, consisting of not more than 6 junior boys, 6 junior girls, 6 cadet boys and 6 cadet girls; any other Association shall be entitled to enter up to 20 players consisting of not more than 5 junior boys, 5 junior girls, 5 cadet boys and 5 cadet girls.

ENTRY FORMS:

Entry forms shall be agreed with the General Secretary or Chairman of Technical Committee and shall include a statement, to be signed by an official of the nominating Association/Federation on behalf of its players and captain, that they understand and accept all the terms and conditions of the championships and that they are prepared to compete against all other team and individual participants.

All Hotels are distanced from Sport Hall approximately 3 km. Organizer will provide free of charge transportation between Hotels and Hall in both directions.

HOSPITALITY:

Table Tennis Federation of North Macedonia shall provide **free hospitality** from the dinner on 10th June till the breakfast on 17th June 2019 for:

- The General Secretary
- The BTTU Technical Delegate.

Table Tennis Federation of North Macedonia shall provide **free hospitality** from the dinner on 11th June till the breakfast on 17th June 2018 for:

- 1 Delegate from each Association/Federation,
- 2 International Umpires from each Association/Federation,
- The BTTU honorary members,
- The members of BTTU Technical and Marketing Committee.

The cost of hospitality, based on double room occupancy, for persons from the following list will be **40 € per day** from the dinner on 11th June till the breakfast on 17th June 2018:

- Up to 16 players of a Association/Federation entering with number of four team
- Up to 12 players of a Association/Federation entering with number of three team
- Up to 8 players of a Association/Federation entering with number of two team
- Up to 4 players of a Association/Federation entering with number of one team
- Up to 3 players of a Association/Federation entering players only for individual events
- Up to 4 coaches of a Association/Federation entering with number of 3 or 4 team
- Up to 2 coaches of a Association/Federation entering with number of 1 or 2 team or players only for individual events
- 1 Doctor or physician from each participating Association/Federation

The cost of hospitality, based on double room occupancy, for any other persons not listed above will be **60 € per day**.

Single rooms

Organizer will provide 1 (one) single room for the Delegate of every participating Association/Federation. Any additional request for the single room can be extra charged up to 50% of original price. Exception of extra charge can be made by BTTU Technical Delegate.

Cancellation fees

An Association/Federation cancelling a person of their announced delegation up to the 15 days before the start of Championships have not paid any cancellation fees.

An Association/Federation cancelling a person of their announced delegation between the 7 and 15 days before the start of Championships, have to pay 50% of the hospitality costs for every person and for the whole period this person was initially nominated.

An Association/Federation cancelling a person of their announced delegation during the last 7 days before the start of Championships or arriving with less persons than announced, have to pay 100% of the hospitality costs for every person and for the whole period this person was initially nominated.

TRANSPORTATION:

The organizer will provide shuttle service from and to Skopje (SKP) International Airport as free of charge if Travelling details are submitted before or on by deadline date: **13th May 2019**. Transport between hotel and venue will be provided by organizer free of charge.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be carried in Restaurant "Forza", which is in close proximity to Sport Hall, so we kindly ask all teams to come there.

THE DRAW:

The draw for team events shall be made on 11/06/2019 at 21:00, at the Conference Room in Restaurant "Forza".

The draw for individual events shall be made during the teams events (exact time and place shall be announced). Representatives of participating Association/Federation shall be entitled to attend the draw, which shall be conducted by the Referee.

Seeding for team events shall be done on basis of previously 26th Balkan Youth Table Tennis Championship.

Seeding for individual events shall be done on basis of the latest Balkan Junior and Cadet ranking Lists.

JURY:

The jury shall be consisted by the present members of Technical Committee, a representative of the organising Federation, two delegates from participant Association/Federation (by lot), and the Referee or his Deputy.

The chairman of the Jury shall be the Technical Delegate.

All members of the jury have the right to speak and vote except the Referee or his Deputy, who shall have the right to speak but not to vote.

The jury shall meet on the 11/06/2019 at 20:00 and at any other time when necessary.

SYSTEM OF PLAY:

1. Teams events

Team events will be played according to the Rules of Balkan Table Tennis Union for Youth Table Tennis Championships:

First stage (preliminary group) in which will be played on round-robin basis, and Second stage in which will be played on Knock-out basis.

Number of groups will be determined by BTTU Technical Committee after conclusion of Final entries.

In Junior team event the order of play in matches will be A v X, B v Y, C v Z, A v Y, B v X and the match shall end when a team has won 3 individual matches, each the best of 5 games. Draw for ABC or XYZ will be held before the start of the match.

In Cadet team event the order of play in matches will be A v X, B v Y, doubles, A v Y, B v X and the match shall end when a team has won 3 individual matches, each the best of 5 games. Draw for ABC or XYZ will be held before the start of the match.

2. Individual events

Singles events shall be played on two stages, Preliminary group and the Main draw. Preliminary group shall be played on round-robin basis with 3, 4 or 5 players with matches determined by the best of 5 games.

The Main draw shall be played on a Knock-out basis with matches determined by the best of 7 games.

Doubles events shall be played on a Knock-out basis with matches determined by the best of 5 games.

Consolation event in which take part players not qualified for Main draw will be played on a Knock-out basis with matches determined by the best of 5 games.

SCHEDULE (provisional):

12^{ve} June - team events - preliminary groups

13th June - team events - final stage

14th June (morning session) - singles preliminary groups

14th June (afternoon session) - Main Draw for singles and doubles events

15th June - Main and Consolation Draw for single events, Main Draw for doubles events

16th June - semi-finals and finals for singles and doubles events

Table Tennis Federation of North Macedonia shall appoint a number of International Umpires to officiate the matches. All other Association/Federation may appoint up to 2 (two) International Umpire.

For any matches the Umpires shall be from Association/Federation other than those of the players in the match.

TROPHIES AND AWARDS:

Table Tennis Federation of North Macedonia shall present plaques or cups to the winners of team and individual events. In addition, medals and diplomat shall be presented to all members, including non-playing captains of teams placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in team events and to winners, runner up and losing semi-finalist of individual events.

Small gift shall be presented to all winner and runner up in Consolation events.

FLAGS AND ANTHEMS:

During the awarding ceremony for both team and individual events, the national flags of winners, runner up and losing semi-finalist shall be raised and the national anthems of winners shall be played.
